Two Computer Science Majors Introduced

Regis College will offer two new computer science majors, one leading to a bachelor of science degree in computer science and management and the other leading to a bachelor of science degree in computer information systems. They will be available to students beginning in the fall of 1983.

President David M. Clarke, S.J., announced, "Regis offers the computer degrees to prepare students to meet indus-

increasing technological demands and the growing need among students for training in the computer science fields. More than 350 students are currently enrolled in computer science classes in Colorado Springs and Denver."

The first of two majors, computer science and management, focuses on hardware and software design; the other, computer information systems, specializes in software applications. The goal of both programs is to develop technical competence, an understanding of information management, and sound communication skills.

Both computer science programs attempt to foster in students the ability:

- 1) to write intelligible, well-documented computer programs;
- to distinguish what general types of problems are amenable to computer solution;
- 3) to understand basic hardware component arrangements;
- 4) to assume a leadership role in business or industry with an understanding of basic business and management practices and their ethical implications.

Dr. Harry Alderman, Director of Academic Computing, notes that the computer science program is designed to be timely to industry. He states, "Course content was developed in conjunction with experts in specialized areas of computer science and information systems. The content will updated continually to reflect the latest developments in relevant areas such as Database Management and Data Communications and Networking."

Wilson Fellow Visits Campus

Regis College was honored by the weeklong visit of a Woodrow Wilson Fellow Daniel A. Sharp, Director of International Relations for Xerox Corporation, from March 13 to 18, 1983.

Sharp's visit and subsequent Wilson Fellow visits are made possible through a grant from the Woodrow Wilson National Fellowship Foundation. As an institutional participant in the Wilson Visiting Fellows Program, Regis will host major public figures on campus each semester to interact with faculty and students, provide additional resources to regular classes, and offer everyone an opportunity to exchange views on major public issues.

During his visit, Sharp participated in discussion groups with classes as well as a number of public seminars and presentations on campus.

Sharp, who has worked for the U.S. Government, directing Peace Corps oper-

ations in Bolivia and Cusco, Peru, and has served as Deputy Attorney-General for the State of California, has been a pioneer in proactive international relations with the Xerox Corporation.

Xerox encourages overseas managers to have frequent contacts with key government decision-makers. Sharp contends that Xerox' relations with their host governments can determine profitability and also their ability to continue business

Regis at Colorado Springs Offers MBA

Regis College in Colorado Springs launched the Master's Degree Program in Business Administration with 32 students in March 1983. Those students are employed at more than 15 Colorado Springs firms, including Mountain Bell, Hewlett-Packard, Honeywell, Digital, Ford Aerospace, Control Data, Rolm, Colorado National Bank, Otero Savings, the City of Colorado Springs, Penrose Hospital, and American Express.

Regis College President David M. Clarke, S.J., notes that the offering is identical to the highly successful MBA Program currently available at the Denver campus. "The Regis MBA Program is designed for working professionals endeavoring to increase their skills and deepen their understanding of the tasks of management with a graduate degree which emphasizes finance and accounting and

focuses on business ethics," states Clarke. Joyce Findlay, Assistant Director of the MBA Program in Colorado Springs, notes "The growth and expansion of high technology firms in Colorado Springs has created an increasing demand for management-level employees. The MBA offers working professionals an opportunity to learn and refine valuable management skills which may increase their value to their employers and job mobility within their organizations."

The Program consists of ten three-semester-hour courses, seven required and three elected; up to seven additional courses may be required for those students who lack sufficient preparation in the graduate fundamentals of business. Admission is open to men and women who hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution in any field of study.



habits and discipline of how to learn are essential. The broader the person's education, the more readily he can see connections of events, internationally as well as locally, and appreciate other cultures.

"Personally I encourage all undergraduates to visit other countries in order to gain a wider perspective. Unlike European nations, the United States is geographically isolated. Therefore, we must work harder to learn about other cultures as well as acquiring a knowledge of our own history and economics.

Regarding his time at Regis College, Sharp commented, "Coming to Regis, with my educational experience at Berkeley and Harvard, I realize what people miss at larger schools. I am impressed by the personalized attention that students receive and the real dedication of faculty. These considerations are of particular concern to me now as my own children are making decisions about where to attend college."

Sharp earned his bachelor of arts in political science and international relations from the University of California, Berkeley, and his J.D. from Harvard Law School.

Weckbaugh Scholars Recognized

In the face of dwindling federal and state financial aid monies and the increasing economic challenges which confront students and their families in meeting educational expenses, contributions from individuals and organizations become more and more significant in assuring that academically-talented but financially-needy students will continue to be able to take advantage of Regis programs, a dedicated faculty, and the rich tradition of academic excellence and value-centered education.

Ten years ago, one Colorado family established a scholarship fund "to provide financial support to deserving Colorado students who evidence potential ability in religious leadership." The Ella Mullen Weckbaugh Memorial Scholarship, established by the Weckbaugh family in 1973, has since helped seven Regis students, two of whom are current students, in meeting their educational expenses.

When programs like this are established, Regis is well aware that donors have certain expectations about the benefits which

will result from their sponsorship. Regis takes very special pride in the students who have benefited from the Weckbaugh Scholarship Program and who have, without exception, demonstrated distinguished scholarship and service both at Regis and throughout their professional careers.

The 1974-75 scholarship recipient, Lindsey Wess, graduated summa cum laude as a religious studies and English major and was distinguished as a Regis Scholar. After three years of community service work after Regis, he continued on to the University of California at Santa Barbara where he is currently pursuing a Ph.D. in

Comparative Religions.

John W. Lay, the 1975-76 award winner, graduated magna cum laude with concentrations in religious studies, psychology, education, and philosophy. He attended graduate school at Dayton University, Ohio, where he received a master's degree in Theological Studies. After completing his graduate work, he directed religious education programs for two parishes and five missions for the Archdiocese of Denver and currently is completing his fourth year of teaching theology at Regis Jesuit High School. He also serves as a parish volunteer for teacher training and adult education and is involved with ministry education programs co-sponsored by the Episcopal Diocese of Colorado and the Archdiocese of Denver.

John Cronan received Weckbaugh scholarship support in 1977-79 and completed his degree magna cum laude in religious studies. He has since directed religious education for St. James Elementary School and the St. Thomas More Center in Denver.

The 1979-80 recipient, Andrea Lang, was a religious studies major and anthropology minor at Regis and graduated magna cum laude as an Alpha Sigma Nu Scholar. She currently serves as a full-time campus minister for students and faculty at the John XXIII Catholic University Center at Colorado State University, Ft. Collins, and plans to pursue her advanced degree in pastoral theology in the coming year.

Carol Crowley, the 1980-81 and 1981-82 award-winner, completed a triple major in religious studies, philosophy, and English Honors, served in 1981-82 as Alpha Sigma Nu National Jesuit Honor Society President, and was accorded no less than six

senior honors at commencement. She is currently Assistant Registrar at Regis College, has completed one children's novel and is working on a second, and plans to begin graduate work in Religious Studies within the next year.

Current recipients are seniors Judy Dorenkamp of Holly, Colorado, and Daniel Leister of Denver. Both are religious studies and philosophy majors. Judy maintains a 3.0 grade point average while working at the Mullen Home operated by the Little Sisters of the Poor, She is considering a religious vocation and hopes to teach elementary religion. Dan has earned a 4.0 grade point average and membership in Alpha Sigma Nu National Jesuit Honor Society while teaching religion at Marycrest High School and several local parishes. He has applied to graduate school to pursue his Ph.D. in religious studies and later teach college-level religion and philosophy.

Electronic Library Facilities Installed at Colorado Springs

Regis College in Colorado Springs has recently installed a computer terminal to access the Penrose Public Library's inventory as well as a microfiche reader/printer to provide access to and hard copy for selected business journals.

Regis College is among 500 electronic library users in El Paso County. The Penrose Public Library is the only library in the country that allows home user access to its system.

According to Carol Shannon, spokesperson for the Pikes Peak Library District (PPLP), "PPLP is known internationally for the computerization of its library catalogues. The computer system installed at Regis College is relatively unique to the Rocky Mountain Region. Although other organizations have catalogues on line with our system, Regis College's immediate access to reference materials is in-

novative."

Dr. Leon Flancher, Dean of Career Programs, states that "Electronic library facilities will become an essential tool for students in the 21st century. Regis College is installing the electronic facilities in response to student needs for instant access to information. Students will no longer need to spend time traveling to library and research facilities and will be able to make better use of their study time."

Currently one terminal is in place on the Regis campus, and three more terminals will be installed by July 1983. The new electronic library facilities will aid more than 700 undergraduate students currently enrolled at Regis as well as 32 graduate students enrolled in the Master's Degree Program in Business Administration, which was launched in Colorado Springs this spring.

Regis College students who have personal computers at home or work can access the system from their residences or businesses. In addition to access to the Library's inventory, which provides title, author, subject, and call number catalouging, users also have access to community information files.

"Blue Ribbon Panel" on Core Curriculum Announced

Regis College President David M. Clarke, S.J., announced the appointment of a "Blue Ribbon Panel" to evaluate and revise the core curriculum, which must be completed as a part of graduation requirements by all Regis students.

Clarke notes that the objective of the Panel will be to improve the current core so that "Regis College can provide an educational base which will support students' abilities to learn quickly and well, to think logically and critically, to define a personal sense of values and social responsibility, and to develop the skills and leadership abilities necessary for distinguished professional service."

The Panel is expected to establish competencies which every graduate must demonstrate, such as proficiency in writing, proficiency in oral expression, computer literacy, quantiative analytic skills, and exposure to at least one other culture. Procedures may also be explored which would allow students to challenge or test out of requirements.

Blue Ribbon Panel members include: Dr. Ronald Walker, Senior Vice President and Dean of Faculty at Loyola University of Chicago; Dr. Thomas Staley '52, Provost at the University of Tulsa; and Patrick J. Ford, S.J., Professor of Education at Gonzaga University, Spokane, Washington; Dr. John Kane, Associate Professor of Religious Studies; and John W. Muth, of the Regis College Career Education faculty.

The Panel's final report and recommendations will be presented to the College's Educational Policies Committee (EPC) by August 15, 1983; reviewed by EPC and the President; and submitted to the Board of Trustees by December 1983 for their action.

Regis Mourns Blichmann and O'Sullivan Deaths



Harvey P. Blichmann, member of the Regis College Board of Trustees, Vice President for Stragetic Planning for Public Service of Colorado, and prominent Denver business and civic leader, died of a heart attack in Denver on January 9, 1983. He was 55 years old.

Blichman served on the Regis Board of Trustees for seven years. He participated in the Regis College Community Campaign from 1977-80, served on the Task Force on Values and Ethics of the National Commission of the Future of Regis College, and was a member of the Regis College President's Council.

He is survived by his widow, Blanche, and two daughters, Nancy and Suzanne Ernster '80.



Regis College Emeritus Professor of English, Robert J. O'Sullivan, S.J., died of cancer in Fusz Pavilion, a Jesuit nursing home in St. Louis, Missouri, on February 21, 1983. He was 73 years old.

Father O'Sullivan taught English at Regis and moderated various campus publications for 15 years. The Robert J. O'Sullivan Center, a theater and office building on campus, was named in his honor in November 1982.

Father O'Sullivan was a Professor of English at Rockhurst College in Kansas City and moderator of various campus publications from 1948 to 1960. From 1960 to 1967, he was Dean of St. Louis University's College of Philosophy and Letters at Florissant, Missouri.

Alumnus Dr. Martin Murphy: Cancer Research Pioneer


"Instantly captivating, enthusiastic, cheerful, and buoyant . . . part St. Francis of Assisi, part Roger Bacon, a pinch of Pasteur, a dollop of Einstein, and a generous jigger of Dale Carnegie." Dr. Martin Murphy '64, Director of the Bob Hipple Laboratory for Cancer Research, is so described by the Editor of *The Journal Herald* in Dayton, Ohio. Murphy is the type of man who inspires praise from the press as well as his professional colleagues.

Born in Colorado Springs in 1942, Dr. Murphy completed his undergraduate studies at Marquette University, University von Munchen, and Regis College. Murphy graduated from Regis in 1964 with a double major in biology and philosophy and minors in chemistry and German. He earned his master's degree in physiology and his Ph.D. with highest distinction in experimental hematology and oncology at New York University.

Following five post-doctoral years at three distinguished international medical research institutes in Paris, France, Manchester, England, and Canberra, Australia, he joined the staff of the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee. Through his work with childhood cancers, Murphy discovered ways to clone human malignant cells. He transferred to the renowned Sloan-Kettering Institute for Cancer Research in New York City, where, from 1975-79, he served as the Director of the Hemotology Training Program and as Assistant Professor at Cornell University Medical College.

Author of more than 95 scientific and medical publications, Dr. Murphy has received many academic honors and national committee appointments, and he has been elected to membership in more than 20 prestigious professional organizations in the United States as well as in Europe and Australia. He is the Founding Editor-in-Chief of the new scientific journal Stem Cells: The International Journal of Cellular Differentiation and Proliferation.

In 1977, Murphy founded The Bob Hipple Laboratory for Cancer Research at the Sloan-Kettering Institute for Cancer



Research in New York City. The Bob Hipple Laboratory is dedicated to the memory of Daytonian industrialist and civic leader who died of cancer in 1976 and whose friends and colleagues wanted to memorialize him through cancer research in August, 1979. Murphy transferred the Laboratory to Dayton, Ohio, where it became part of Wright State University School of Medicine. From a staff of one investigator, the Bob Hipple Laboratory has grown to a team of 21 professional researchers with more than 60 volunteers. The Bob Hipple Laboratory continues to merit the financial and moral support of the Dayton community.

The goals of The Bob Hipple Laboratory, located in the Miami Valley, are threefold: research, teaching, and service to the medical community. The Laboratory takes a microscopic approach to an immense problem — understanding the process of malignant cell growth. Cancer, either in the blood stream or in solid tissue such as bones, organs, or skin, is the result of an inappropriate and uncontrolled division of cells.

The research team at the Laboratory has succeeded in taking human cells suspected of being cancerous from patients and stimulating those cells to grow and proliferate in a carefully controlled culture that mimics the condition of the human

body. This technique, called "cloning," allows researchers to observe how rapidly the cells divide and redivide and how well new cells perform their vital functions.

One of the most important benefits of "cloning" research is that cultured cancer clones are now being used to test which chemotherapeutic drugs are most effective in treating individual malignant clones. Since cancer cells differ from person to person, a drug that is very effective with one patient may have no positive effects in another. The Laboratory is making significant progress in tailoring cancerspecific therapy to individuals. For example, thanks to experiments documented by the Lab, the clinical usage of an effective anti-cancer drug, the chemotherapeutic agent chlorozotocin, is being accelerated.

The Laboratory is also on the threshold of fundamental discoveries in the molecular biology of cellular control. The communication between cells takes the form of molecular regulators which may serve to instruct or stimulate cell proliferation. If the regulators for malignant cells can be intercepted and altered to direct those cells to produce healthy cells instead, a cure for cancer may not be far away.

In order to properly understand how cells divide, these molecular regulators must first be purified. The Laboratory

staff has successfully identified and purified two glycoproteins: erythropoietin, the molecule which regulates red blood cell production; and thrombopoietin, which regulates megakaryocytes or cells that fragment to produce blood platelets, to molecular homogeneity. The Laboratory's identification, characterization, and purification of the hormone thrombopoietin holds promise in treating leukemia, a disease which is characterized by an abnormal increase in the number of leukocytes or white blood cells in the tissues and often in the blood.

The Laboratory's pioneering staff has also discovered a molecule, which they named "granulopoietin" because it regulates the production of white blood cells called "granulocytes." The discovery of "granulopoietin" has been helpful to leukemia researchers around the world. A major paper concerning the discovery of "granulopoietin" by members of the Laboratory's Hormone Purification Team, scheduled to be published by the National Academy of Sciences in June 1983, and entitled the "Invivo Stimulation of

Murinne Granulopoiesis by Human Urinary Extracts from Patients with Aplastic Anemia," marks an international breakthrough in cancer and leukemia research.

By purifying and identifying specific blood cells, the research team of the Bob Hipple Laboratory has also advanced the science of bone marrow preservation. In the past, bone marrow transplant patients have experienced major problems with intolerance of foreign tissues and consequent marrow rejection. The Laboratory staff has made a major advance in the non-frozen preservation of human bone marrow, which may be of critical value in the treatment of some patients with otherwise terminal tumors.

In reference to the work of the Bob Hipple Laboratory, Dr. Martin Murphy quotes Winston Churchill: "Give us the tools, and we will finish the job.' Thanks to our gifted investigators and dedicated staff and in partnership with practicing physicians, patients, the University, and our many benefactors, we are developing those tools to 'finish the job.' The 'tools' are the powerful technologies of cell

cloning and the profoundly important implements of molecular biology."

Murphy notes that the Jesuit philosophy of education has had a profound influence on his work and on the interaction of his Laboratory with the Dayton community: "My education at Regis influenced me not only by providing a sound academic foundation, but more importantly, by contributing to the development of my ability to think analytically and critically and by providing me with significant role models and mentors who were committed to academic excellence and value-centered education. The same philosophy of contributing to the community that the Jesuits practice and teach is incorporated into my work at the Laboratory.

"The Laboratory has been able to help those who have been touched by a catastrophic disease. Yet, we can take heart in progress from whence hope springs forth. Through studying individuals' illnesses, remedies may be developed for future generations. It will take the efforts of scientists, doctors, fundraisers, journalists, and others to combat cancer, and to write the history in which a cure will be found."
